Project Description:

The unique Nullarbor Links 18-hole par 72 golf course spans 1,365km along the Eyre Highway from Ceduna in South Australia to Kalgoorlie in Western Australia.

The 18 hole course has been developed using a combination of holes loaned from established courses and purpose built holes. Each site in participating towns or roadhouses will include a green and tee and a somewhat rugged outback-style natural terrain fairway.

Scorecards to start the course can be purchased from both the Ceduna or Kalgoorlie visitor information centres and are stamped at all holes along the way in order for golfers to receive a free certificate to commemorate playing the World's longest golf course.

Nullarbor Links was developed to compliment and enhance the tourism industry along the highway by providing travellers with an additional attraction and reason to slow down and enjoy the beauty of the Nullarbor.

The official opening of the course was held in Ceduna on 22nd October 2009 which included an official tee off followed by a formal dinner. The following morning, buses and entourage left Ceduna to complete the 4 day course in Kalgoorlie.
