



Thank you for supporting the 2009 Oysterfest in Ceduna. We appreciate your involvement. Below are some guidelines for your reference.

2009 Oysterfest - "Come out of your shell"

Festival Friday - October 2nd Oysterfest in Ceduna Saturday & Sunday October 3rd & 4th

Site guidelines:

Stalls are available for set up from 12 noon Friday October 2nd until 10.00am Monday October 5th, 2009.

Each exhibitor is required to have their stall set up and open for business from 10am until 6.00pm on Saturday October 3rd and Sunday October 4th. Exhibitors are not eligible for a discount should they choose to attend for only one day.

Please keep your stall and nearby area clean, and free of rubbish.

Exhibitors are responsible for setting up and dismantling their display, and supplying all display boards, power cords, trestle tables, etc.

We do not recommend that any stall be left unattended.

The Oysterfest committee must approve any music or amplified sound from any stall. Please contact us before 1 September 2009 to arrange this.

Each exhibitor must supply a copy of their current Public Liability Insurance at the time of booking.

Exhibitors who require freight for any items are recommended to contact McEvoy Transport, 9 Naweena Road, regency Park, Telephone 08 8346 7835 for any freight or transport arrangements.

Craft exhibitors must have hand-made items available for sale, and must be willing to demonstrate their craft during the Oysterfest.

Safety:

The District Council of Ceduna and the Oysterfest committee accept no responsibility for damage to exhibitors' equipment or damage caused by exhibitors' equipment.

Sufficient fire extinguishers of a suitable type must be kept and easily accessible on every stall where electricity or gas is used.

All electrical cords and equipment must meet current safety requirements.

We do not recommend that glass/china containers of any sort be used to serve refreshments.

Any exhibitor supplying food or drink must abide by current health regulations.

Security:

Security guards will patrol the Oysterfest site each night from 7pm to 7am. However, the Oysterfest committee accept no responsibility for any items on any exhibitors' stall at any time. If any exhibitor intends to remain on site each night, please advise the committee at the time of booking.
